### LOT 1204

A pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jars and covers, Kangxi style but late 19th century, each ovoid body painted with a formal design of lotus and scrolling leafy tendrils, height 11.6cm (one cover restored, the other cover chipped), together with a Chinese blue and white porcelain pot, height 8.7cm (chip to rim), with wood stand.

### Condition Report

1204. Jar 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches to glaze. Cover with a few minor chips to top edge.

Jar 2 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches to glaze. Cover is chipped and restored with overpainting.

The pot has a chipped section of rim, otherwise ok with only typical minor surface scratches and wear.
