A Japanese carved wood, bronze and coral branch paperweight, Meiji period, the coral branch entwined by a bronze snake, on a carved wood slug-form base applied with a bronze frog, length 11.1cm (coral branch broken in two places).

1006. Coral branch is glued in one place and cracked/separated in another, otherwise the bronze is in good condition. Typical minor scuffs and wear to wood section. Possible missing inlaid eyes?
