A Chinese blue and white export porcelain part tea and coffee set, late Qianlong period, each piece painted with a coastal landscape and heightened in gilt, comprising cylindrical teapot and cover, height 13.8cm, sparrow beak cream jug, tea caddy, five teabowls, five coffee cups, five saucers, sugar bowl, cover and saucer stand and slop bowl (some restoration and faults), together with a similarly decorated oval teapot and cover, cream jug and sugar bowl and cover (some faults).

Condition Report

1199. Cylindrical teapot - professionally restored cover, spout and handle.

Cream jug - restored handle and rim.

Tea caddy - small chip to curved top edge near corner, otherwise ok.

5 Teabowls - 2 in good condition with typical light surface scratches to glaze and minor wear to gilt. 1 has been broken in half and professionally restored. 1 has a small chip and hairline to rim, otherwise ok. 1 has a hairline running down from rim and across foot.

5 Saucers - 2 in good condition. 1 with chip to rim and 2 hairlines to rim. 1 with small chip and hairline to rim, and star crack to base. 1 with faint star crack to base.

5 Coffee Cups - 4 in good condition, 1 with chip to rim.

Slop Bowl - restored section of body.

Sugar Bowl and Cover, and slightly larger saucer - bowl with 2 small chips to rim, otherwise ok. Cover in good condition. Saucer with 2 minor chips to rim, otherwise ok.

All items in this set with typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze and gilt.

Oval teapot - restored handle, metal mounted spout end where it was presumably damaged, chip to rim of cover.

Cream jug - restored handle, otherwise ok.

Sugar Bowl and Cover - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt.
