A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, late 19th century, the baluster body painted with dragons amidst peony, height 13.8cm, together with a Japanese blue and white porcelain jar and cover, Meiji period, painted with birds and flowers, height 11.2cm, two Japanese Satsuma earthenware vases, heights 6cm and 9.4cm, and a small Kutani circular dish, diameter 6.8cm.

Condition Report

1247. Chinese blue and white vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Lacking cover.

Japanese blue and white jar and cover - appears to be in good condition, but small star cracks visible to side, otherwise no other chips, cracks or repairs.

Small Satsuma cylindrical vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical wear to gilt.

Other Satsuma vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing and typical wear to gilt.

Small Kutani dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing.
