A collection of Chinese export porcelain, 18th century, including a famille rose cylindrical coffee can, Kangxi period, painted with flowers, height 6.1cm, a Nanking Cargo blue and white pine tree pattern teabowl and saucer, a famille rose Mandarin palette coffee cup, Qianlong period, painted with figures, height 6.5cm, and an iron red and green enameled porcelain bowl, mark of Jiaqing, painted with lotus, scrolling foliage and gilt characters within underglaze blue borders, underglaze blue seal mark to base, diameter 13cm (cracked and repaired). Provenance: the property of a West Sussex private collector.

Condition Report

1028. Famille rose coffee can - crack to bottom of handle, otherwise good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Mandarin palette cup - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Good vibrant colours.

Nanking Cargo teabowl and saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Iron red decorated bowl - 6 hairlines to rim. 3cm x 4.5cm 'U' shaped section of rim broken out and reglued. Minor rim chips.

Famille rose teabowl - 3.5cm hairline to rim, otherwise ok.

Famille rose saucer - small star crack to side and a few minor chips, otherwise ok.

Cup and cover - small chip to rim of cover, otherwise in good order.

Matching shaped oval stand - minor rim nicks, otherwise ok.

Blue, gilt and white saucer - good condition.

Famille rose saucer with cornucopia - restored section of rim, otherwise ok.
