A George III silver gilt honey pot and stand in the form of a bee skep, the detachable cover with circular wreath finial, the circular stand with conforming border, London 1798 by Paul Storr, total weight 450.6g, height 11.5cm, diameter of stand 14cm. Note: a very similar silver gilt honey pot by Paul Storr was sold at Christie's, 6th June 2017, Lot 116, and another at Sotheby's, 12th May 2015, Lot 155.

Condition Report

500. Overall in good condition with no obvious damage or repair. Some typical light wear to gilt, slightly more pronounced on the highpoints and finial, and more noticeable on the stand.

No signs of previous erasure to finial centre. Good clear matching hallmarks on all 3 pieces.
