A pair of Art Nouveau silver and enamelled posy vases, each ovoid body with bulbous neck and four loop handles, decorated with spiral stems of stylized flowers enamelled in shades of blue and green, Birmingham 1906 by James Fenton & Co, weight 167.8g, height 9.2cm.

Condition Report

501. One vase has four sizeable dents to the body and a misshapen rim.

The other vase has smaller dents to the body, damage to one of the foliate enamel decorations and a dent to one of the loop handles.

Both have wear consistent with age and use.
