Circle of George Engleheart - a late 18th century oval half-length portrait miniature depicting a gentleman wearing a blue coat, watercolour on ivory, 7.3cm x 5.4cm, within a gold mounted frame inset with a woven hair surround, the reverse with a further glazed woven hair compartment and a blue enamelled border, total height 10.3cm.

Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

Condition Report

2365. A very thin line is visible to the ivory, approx 1cm long and probably a hairline crack rather than just a surface scratch. Lacking glass to front, there is a crack to the blue glass border at the rear and minor age related wear to the frame.
