A gold and opal brooch, designed as a foliate wreath, mounted with six circular opals, unmarked, weight 5.3g, width 2.8cm, a blue and colourless gem set floral brooch and a single row necklace of freshwater cultured pearls on a gem set clasp.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

739. Opal brooch - two claws to one opal are slightly distorted, otherwise in good condition.

Blue & colourless gem brooch - probably of Indian manufacture, some windowing to the blue sapphires.

Cultured pearl necklace - both sides of clasp wired to cotton stand, so unable to open clasp - length from clasp to centre of necklace (ie half the necklace) is 28.8cm. Clasp diameter 1.6cm. One claw to central coral is missing, edge of coral damaged, one inner seed pearl replaced and glued into position.

Unmarked to exterior, but believe it to be low grade gold, possibly 9ct.

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
