LOT 787

A diamond, coral and seed pearl pendant, 1920s, with a tassel drop, unmarked, weight 3.1g, length 6.8cm.

Estimate: £200 - £250

Condition Report

787. Oval coral bead has two small very fine old hairline cracks, possibly caused at the time the coral was drilled to fit the pin.

The image shows a worn-like blemish which is just surface fluff - now removed.

Hemi-spherical coral has a very fine hairline crack to one side which extends from top to bottom, possibly caused at time of drilling to fit pin.

Rose cut diamonds look to be fairly clear with only one or two inclusions.

Seed pearls have an attractive lustre and are of attractive appearance. One pearl has cracks.

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
