An 18th century Continental walnut cassone, the hinged lid above a front panel carved with two opposing soldiers on horseback commencing battle, flanked by flower-charged urns, the side panels also carved with flowering urns, height 82cm, width 171cm, depth 65cm (later carving and some historic woodworm).

Condition Report

2117. The chest has had numerous areas of restoration, including a later strip of wood added to the centre of the lid, and various repairs to splits on the side and front panels. Some overall extensive woodworm to some areas, including base boards, which have been covered with a piece of hardwood to the interior.
