### LOT 2128

A fine early 20th century French satinwood and foliate inlaid vitrine, the shaped green marble top above a gilt metal mounted frieze and a single glazed door, height 100.5cm, width 80cm, depth 36cm.

Estimate: £1,200 - £1,800

### Condition Report

2128. The general overall appearance and condition is good, but there are a few minor faults that come with its age.

The top has some minor surface scratches and a few very minor chips to the edges. There is a small section of wooden moulding missing just under the rear right side of the top. The band of mounts are finely cast and all present.

There are a few small minor surface grazes to the edges of the uprights, including a small bump to left hand side front corner.

The interior base panel has two thin cracks which are not that visible from the front.

Both of the glass shelves have chips to a corner, so perhaps could do with replacing.

Otherwise one of the rear legs is slightly loose, but does not affect the cabinet as it stands.

No woodworm.

Stands firmly and level.

Lock works and key is present.

The door opens and closes ok, but is a snug fit so has worn at the bottom edge.
