Luigi Romoli, after Fra Angelico - Angel Musicians, a pair of 19th century oils with gilt and sgraffito on arched panels, each with signed artist labels verso, both 42cm x 15cm. Note: Professor Luigi Romoli's repository was at 11 via Borgognissanti, Florence and specialised in copies of works by Fra Angelico and Giulio Romano. He exhibited at the Great Exhibition, London, in 1851, the 1876 Vienna Universal Exhibition and the 1876 International Exhibition, Philadelphia, USA, amongst others.

Condition Report

39. Angel with horn - considerable loss of gesso and paint along the bottom of the panel and smaller areas of loss to the edges. Some other areas of loss to the extremities. Craquelure and dirt to surface. Also some scratching to the surface. The gilt has also dulled in places.

Other Angel - some crude repairs to gilt around edges. Some subsequent chipping to gesso with associated loss of paint. Also some scratching to the surface and some dirt. The gilt has dulled in places.
