A late Victorian silver two-handled cup of tapering cylindrical half-reefed form, the front inscribed 'The Handicraft and Cookery Cup...' opposing 'Small Dole W.I. Flower of the Month', on a circular foot, London 1895 by Horace Woodward & Co Ltd, height 8cm, together with a silver quich with tab handles, the front inscription engraved 'Hurstpierpoint Women's Institute |Penney Cup|...', Sheffield 1914 by Martin Hall & Co, length 19.2cm, total weight 426g.

### Condition Report

411. Cup in fairly good condition, slightly misshapen rim and small tear and repair to edge of one handle/rim join. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Engraved inscription to both sides. Slightly misshapen foot so slightly wobbly. Slightly rubbed hallmarks.

Quich in generally good condition, engraved inscription to both sides, four small dents to body. Typical surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.
