## LOT 627

A Victorian gold and aquamarine pendant brooch, the top mounted with an oval cut aquamarine in a scroll pierced design, with a pendant drop mounted with a pear shaped aquamarine, unmarked, weight 13.6g, width 4.3cm, length 8cm.

Estimate: £500 - £700

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## Condition Report

The piece is slightly bent. From the back of the piece, the metal oval supporting the aquamarine is bent, a couple of the prongs connecting this to the main body are worn.

The front section of the brooch supporting the drop is a little askew. No obvious signs of repair however. The oval aquamarine has some scratching to the right side, with some abrasion to facet edges.

The pear aquamarine has an eye visible inclusion on the right side, small in nature but it reflects the light and is quite noticeable. Some abrasion to facet edges.

The pin is in working order.

Some slight discoloration to the gold.

Otherwise with typical light wear.
