A George III silver egg cruet stand of rectangular form with central seed head and foliate handle above six circular apertures within a gadrooned and scallop shell cornered rim, raised on foliate supports, on a similarly decorated base and tapering reeded feet, London 1807 by John Emes, weight 543.6g, height 19cm, length 17.2cm (lacking egg cups).

Condition Report

509. PLEASE NOTE - amendment to catalogue description. This is an egg cruet not a condiment cruet, which is just lacking its egg cups.

There has been a small solder repair at the handle joint beneath the finial. Otherwise, it is in generally good order with no significant damage. Typical light surface scratches and wear and minor misshaping.
