An Edwardian silver rectangular snuff box, the hinged lid embossed with a scene of a lady and gentleman accompanied by two figures on horseback, import mark Chester 1904 by Berthold Muller, length 6.8cm, a silver rectangular snuff box, the hinged lid embossed with an interior scene of a lady and three gentlemen, above gun dogs and pheasants in a woodland, Birmingham 1900 by Thomas Hayes, length 5.5cm, total weight 86.4g, and an early 19th century silver snuff box, the hinged lid and base inset with abalone, marks rubbed, length 5.5cm.

### Condition Report

490. Berthold Muller box - generally good condition, minor light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage. Lid closes tightly. Good clear hallmark. Minor repair to bottom edge of one side.

Other embossed box - generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good. Good clear hallmarks. Lid closes tightly. Small dent to inside left back corner.

Silver and abalone box - generally good condition, but with some wear. Tiny dent to back left corner of lid, but not obviously noticeable. Abalone base panel is cracked and chipped. Typical light surface scratches and marks rubbed.
