Condition Report

495. Good condition. Good crisp engraving. Only minor surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Spring hinge is good. Interior with typical light wear and scuffs, but no significant damage.

The pencil is in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage and no apparent cracks, tears or repairs. Appears to operate correctly and rotates as it should but please note there is currently no lead in the pencil. Cannot measure the lead accurately, but it appears to be 1mm - please be aware that this is an estimate only.
