### LOT 517

A Victorian silver Persian style four-piece tea set, each piece of baluster form, decorated in relief with stylized palmettes within beaded borders, comprising teapot, hot water pot, two-handled sugar bowl and milk jug, London 1872 and 1873 by Robert Hennell IV, total weight 2599.7g, height of hot water pot 27cm. Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

### Condition Report

517. All four pieces with good crisp decoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear to highpoints. Engraved initials to panel on each. All with good clear matching hallmarks with teapot, hot water pot and sugar bowl London 1872, milk jug London 1873.

Teapot - bent/pushed down foot, hinge good, lid closes tightly and handle good and secure with no movement.

Hot water pot - slight wobble to foot, where slightly misshapen/bent, hinge is good, lid closes with only a very minor gape. Handle is good and secure with no movement.

Sugar bowl - small dent to initial cartouche, otherwise in good order.

Milk jug - good condition, only very minor wobble to foot, but no obvious misshaping.
