An Omega Automatic Seamaster stainless steel cased gentleman's chronograph bracelet wristwatch, circa 1972, the signed and jewelled 1040 caliber movement numbered '35598957', the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, date aperture, two subsidiary dials and inner tachymeter scale, the case with two buttons to side, the signed case back interior detailed '176.007', the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case width 3.8cm.

Condition Report

1065. The watch is in generally good condition with only typical minor surface scratches and wear to case, glass and bracelet.

Movement winds and adjusts smoothly, date rolls over as it should and it is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The chrono feature works sporadically, sometimes the blue centre seconds hand does not move at all when button is pushed, other times it moves for 4-5 seconds then stops and bottom button returns it to 12/upright.

The dial has some loss to markings around the edge, otherwise at first glance looks to be good.

Bracelet in generally good order, clasp in working order.

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
