### LOT 1221

A late 20th century French lacquered brass corniche cased calendar carriage alarm clock by L'Epée, the eight day movement striking and repeating on a gong, the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, outer Arabic minutes and moonphase aperture above subsidiary day, alarm and date dials, inscribed 'Angelus', the backplate with stamped 'L'Epée' maker's mark, the glazed case with swing handle, on bracket feet, height 17.4cm, with winding key.

### Condition Report

1221. The clock is in generally good condition. Gilt lacquer to the top of the case has worn off, but rest of case in good order. Dial in good condition. Glass in good condition. Winds and adjusts smoothly, days and dates roll over, alarm train winds but does not stike, repeat mechanism stikes as it should. Other than the alarm, the clock is running and keeping good time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
