LOT 1719

A Loetz Lataniaglas bowl, circa 1906, the clear bulbous body with everted frill rim, applied with green chiné type threads to the top half, unmarked, height 12.5cm, together with a Phaenomen type vase with opal body and yellow trailed design, height 21cm, and a clear vase with purple wave design beneath a folded rim, height 10cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

Lataniaglas - a few deep scratches to the exterior clear part of the lower body. Missing a few small sections of green trailing which is only noticeable on very close inspection. Otherwise ok.

Yellow vase - small manufacturing inclusion to body of glass between neck and lower body causing a little air bubble fracture to the glass, not damage but a manufacturing issue, only noticeable on close inspection when viewed in the right light and at the right angle. Otherwise in good condition.

Purple vase - some scratches to exterior on close inspection, otherwise ok.

No marks or signatures on any of the items in the lot.
