LOT 1758

Three craquelure ice glass comports with entwined red snake decoration to the stems, Bohemian or French, circa 1850, comprising a pair, height 19cm, and a single, height 22cm, together with a matching centrepiece with white snake detail and replacement fitted trumpet insert with red entwined snake, total height 38cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

The single larger red snake comport and the white snake comport each have minor nicks to the top rim edge, very inconspicuous and only noticeable on very close inspection.

Overall there is wear/rubbing to the gilding to varying degrees.

The trumpet insert is not original to the white snake entwined base, and in reality is probably a base itself rather than an insert, although it is a good fit in the white snake entwined base.

Otherwise each piece in good condition.
