An Art Deco French varicoloured onyx, slate and spelter mantel clock garniture, the clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the silvered lozenge shaped dial with black Arabic hour numerals and inscribed 'Lavelle Boulogne Sur Mer', the rectangular case surmounted with a spelter panther, height 34.5cm, with pendulum and winding key, flanked by a pair of matching ornaments.

Condition Report

1260. Case in generally good condition. Typical surface scratches, minor nicks and wear commensurate with age. Both trains of movement wind smoothly, but it only runs for a short while before stopping. The thin silvered dial is turned up in one corner.

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
