A Loetz Tango glass vase, circa 1930, designed by Michael Powolny, the pale green body decorated with black vertical lines beneath the black edged rim, unmarked, height 14cm, together with a similar orange example, height 12.5cm (chip to rim). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Green - in good condition with no damage or repairs - the surface of the glass is heavily scratched to the foot through normal wear and there are a number of surface inclusions to the body of the glass, a manufacturing issue. One of the black lines has a large burst air bubble to its surface on the underside of the vase, please see image 3 on our website. Otherwise typical surface scratches commensurate with age and use.

Orange - chip to top rim edge approx 1.5cm long by 0.5cm wide, with associated curved fissure/crack to body of glass beneath this, please see images 7 and 8 on our website. Again there are a number of inclusions to the body of the glass but to a lesser extent than the green example. Similar surface scratches commensurate with age and use.
