A matched garniture of three Stourbridge satin glass Coraline bead vases, late 19th century, each cased in graduated pink over an opal interior, decorated with luminescent beads in a weed or coral branch pattern, height 24cm, together with a similar two-handled vase, height 19cm, and a small group of similar Coraline bead decorated wares, including two pairs of vases and a bowl and cover (minor faults).
Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Each piece fundamentally in good condition with no repairs and no significant damage.

The powder bowl has a very minor chip to the inner edge of the cover.

The two handled vase has losses to the bead work which are more extreme than you would expect.
