### LOT 1710

A threaded clear glass Kuttrolf or Cluck Cluck decanter and stopper, late 19th century, engraved 'Whisky' to the shoulders, height 29cm, a pair of iridescent cranberry glass ewer decanters and stoppers with trailed surface decoration, height 29cm, a Grand Marnier silver and gilt cameo green glass decanter and stopper, height 21cm (neck repaired), and a small group of other similar wares, including two craquelure jugs with ice compartments. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

Cluck Cluck decanter - matched stopper which is actually a good fit, it does have a small flat chip to its flat base end. Otherwise the decanter is in good condition.

Amber tinted crackle decanter and stopper - small polished chip to top rim edge which also has two small bruises.

Cut amber decanter with long vertical ribs - large vertical crack to body.

Green tinted crackle decanter and stopper - long vertical crack to neck.

Pink decanter and stopper with incredibly badly rubbed/worn gilding overall and small nick to top tip of stopper.

One of the cranberry decanters has a rough finish to its lower handle terminal.

Grand Marnier decanter has glued repair and associated crack to neck - see images 6 and 7 on our website.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition overall.
