### LOT 1231

An early 20th century French brass, onyx and champlévé enamel four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong and mercury compensated pendulum, the circular dial with black Arabic hour numerals and flower festoons, the case with bevelled glass panels, on bracket feet, height 27.2cm, with winding key (minor faults).

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### Condition Report

1231. The case has some chips to edges and corners. Small repair to onyx on back right corner of top and front left corner of base. Both hinged doors are good. Glass panels in good condition. Brass in good order, but a little dull and dusty. Dial has hairlines around winding holes and across the 12 o'clock area. Both trains of the movement wind smoothly and the clock is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Strike mechanism also in good working order.
