Four craquelure ice glass jugs, French or Bohemian, mid-19th century, each entwined with a gilt decorated red snake, height of tallest 36cm, together with a matching comport and a trumpet shaped vase, height 34cm (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Trumpet shaped vase - indistinct flat chip to inner top rim edge and minor chip to outside edge of foot.

Comport with minute nick to tip of snake's tail.

One of the jugs has a large glued break with associated chip and crack to its foot.

There are varying degrees of wear to the gilding overall.

Otherwise each piece is in good condition with no damage or repairs.
