A craquelure ice glass matched part service, mid to late 19th century, each piece with gilt diamond or line detail, comprising three comports, two centrepieces with frosted dolphin stem supports, height 22cm, a jug, height 37.5cm, a vase, height 25.5cm, a bowl and cover in the form of a pear, various leaf and shell shaped dishes and a goblet, together with a green centrepiece with dolphin stem support. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Large jug - foot has been reattached with glued repair.

Pear shaped bowl and cover has a large chip to the base's inner rim edge, and a small chip to the outer rim edge of the cover.

There are varying degrees of wear to the gilding overall, but otherwise the pieces in the lot are in good condition overall.
