A mixed group of mostly Stourbridge air trap satin glassware, late 19th century, including vases, jugs and bowls, predominantly with a quilted diamond design but also chevrons, stripes and spots, in blue, pink, yellow, green and caramel colours, height of tallest vase 27.5cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

36 items in the lot in total.

Pair of caramel coloured vases - necks possibly reduced and one neck has nibbled chipping.

Pink triple ringed neck vase has bruise to side and scratches to widest part of body.

Pink ground jug with tiny bruise to widest part of body.

Very pale blue whitish vase significantly bruised.

Pale blue vase with chipping to rim.

Narrow necked blue ground vase with minor chipping to neck rim.

Whitish blue high shouldered vase with bruising to body.

Yellow ground vase with minor bruise to side.

Remaining items in the lot in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
