LOT 1890

A mixed group of Stourbridge satin glass Coraline bead vases, late 19th century, cased in graduated pink, orange or pale blue over an opal interior, decorated with luminescent beads, comprising two pairs with a cross design, a pair and two singles with a wheat design, together with a small group of similarly decorated wares (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Pair of orange vases decorated with wheat - one of the pair has a noticeable curve shaped bruise to the inner rim edge.

Pair of orange vases decorated with a cross design - one of the pair has a very minor manufacturing blemish to the neck rim interior.

Squat yellow vase with foliate stems - cracks to the body of the glass.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

There are some typical losses to the beads, nothing untoward, and varying typical degrees of wear to the gilding.
