Condition Report

1820. Both vases in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. No chips or cracks. Typical light surface wear to gilt decoration. Few minor specks/blemishes to frosted ground, but not of any real significance. Minor bubble blemish to inside of neck, but again of no real significance.
