### LOT 3208

A late 19th century French Gras bayonet with single-edged fullered blade, blade length 52.5cm, dated 1877, with steel scabbard, numbered '82756', together with an early 19th century sabre (relic found condition), a Mandingo tribe sword and a small African leg knife.

3208. Small African leg knife - Some surface rust to blade. Chips and losses to pommel. Scabbard - some chips and losses to board edge, breakdown to fibre binding and small chips to tip. Top of scabbard would probably have been bound, colour difference noticeable and boards of scabbard not loose at top end. Total length inc scabbard 29cm, total length of knife 27.5cm, length of blade 20.5cm.
