### LOT 575

A white gold, diamond and aquamarine pendant brooch in a foliate and scroll pierced openwork design, mounted with an oval cut aquamarine to the centre and a pear shaped aquamarine to the drop, otherwise set with circular cut diamonds, detailed '18ct', weight 13.4g, length 6.9cm, width 4.4cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

### Condition Report

Quite crudely constructed.

A mixture of diamond cuts from rose to round brilliants. One diamond lacking, one or two other diamonds slightly loose in settings.

Some areas of gold showing through to a yellower colour.

Pin secures into place, but a little thin and bent.

There is daylight around the immediate setting of the central aquamarine, it appears secure at the moment but is poorly set.

Diamonds vary in colour and are generally SI/I stones.

The piece is a 20th century reproduction of an earlier design.

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
