A gold and citrine pendant fob seal, circa 1820, unmarked, weight 24.1g, length 4.5cm, a gold and cornelian fob seal, unmarked, weight 8.9g, and a mid-19th century gilt metal and foil-backed rock crystal fob seal.

### Condition Report

Citrine seal - the odd small scratch/nick to the citrine noticeable under a 10x loupe. Some slight denting to one or two of the sides approximately half way up. Some typical slight scratching to the gold overall.

Cornelian seal - small scratch to the outer edge of the cornelian, otherwise ok. Slight wear to the sides of the setting for the cornelian. Some general rubbing/slight scratching to the gold.

Gilt seal - general scratching and abrasion to the rock crystal, with a small chip to a facet edge. Some general heavy loss of gilding overall.
