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### Condition Report

2105. Armchair has overall wear to the leather, a split to the detached button on seat, small tear to lower back cushion and some splits to the seams. Ther armrests appear to have been re-upholstered. Some wear, scuffs and scratches to the plywood shells.

Ottoman is in good condition.

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
