### LOT 505

A gold and platinum fronted, diamond, black onyx and cultured pearl pendant, probably French, circa 1920, in a cruciform design, centred by a single cultured pearl, otherwise set with rose cut diamonds, numbered '7717', weight 6.4g, length 3.4cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

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### Condition Report

One claw securing the onyx at the back has broken off, directly beneath two other claws are chips to the onyx. Under a 10x loupe you can notice the odd blemish to the pearl.

Otherwise, the piece appears to be in generally good condition, with some typical light surface wear/scratching.

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
