Condition Report

325. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Sprung hinge is good and closes tightly. Enamel colours are bright and vibrant. Some minor hairlines to enamel visible under magnification, but nothing of any real significance. Good clear marks. A bit dirty so would benefit from a clean.
