### LOT 2805

A late 17th century stumpwork panel, finely worked in coloured silks, chenille and coral beads with a couple flanking a central fountain, accompanied by a monkey, stag, parrot and foliage, 16cm x 31cm, later protected with a covering of machine net and mounted within a glazed frame.

Estimate: £400 - £600

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### Condition Report

2805. The whole panel has a net covering which obscures the needlework a bit too much, but would assume it has been applied to hold everything in place.

The silk ground looks very worn and split, as well as being quite stained.

Some loss to the embroidery in places.

Possibly some replaced elements to figures including faces.

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
