### Condition Report

2804. Overall typical fading, but generally the needlework vignettes are in reasonable condition. The cream silk ground has some overall splits, wear and some light stains. A few areas of re-stitching, some loss of thread to a few areas and a darker brown stain to lower left corner near squirrel.
