320. Teapot - some small dents around the body, few lead repairs around the body as well. A vacant cartouche applied to one side, probably to cover and thin area. Good clear hallmarks.

Sugar bowl - numerous dents around the body, good clear hallmarks.

Milk jug - few minor dents to body, otherwise ok. Good clear hallmarks.
