Condition Report

422. All with typical light surface scratches and wear. One with slightly misshapen/dented bowl. Generally quite good marks.

The six spoons do look like a set and all date letters are the same, but we think one of the spoons is actually a different maker, even though the maker's mark is indistinct, it is ever so slightly smaller. All the other five are matching.
