A Chinese blue and white porcelain rouleau vase, Kangxi style but late Qing dynasty, the body painted with opposing panels of birds in blossoming branches, reserved against a group of dense lotus and scrolling tendrils, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 45cm (minor glaze fritting).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1020. Generally good condition, with no significant damage or repairs. Minor glaze fritting/loss to underside of rim. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. No cracks or restoration. Overglazed chip/glaze blemish to rim, but not subsequent damage as in manufacture.
