Condition Report

1045. Larger bangle - generally good condition with no significant damage. Typical light surface scratches and wear to silver gilt. Few minor chips to edges of cornelians and minor misshaping to oval surround settings. One side of the serrated edge has had a lead repair.

Smaller bangle - typical light surface scratches and wear. Minor misshpaing to stone surrounds. Couple of minor dents/creases to plain silver interior.
