Two Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, each painted with birds, butterflies and flowers, heights 15.7cm x 15.2cm (one with rim chip), together with a Japanese Satsuma earthenware hexagonal pot, height 5.5cm.

Condition Report

1136. Canton baluster vase - small chip to rim, otherwise in good condition with minor surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels.

Canton bottle vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to enamels and glaze.

Satsuma pot - generally good, missing cover, light crazing and minor wear to gilt.
