A Chinese mirror black glazed porcelain vase, mark of Kangxi and probably early 18th century, of slender baluster form with flared neck, drilled through underglaze blue six-character mark to base, height 29.6cm (drilled hole and chips to base).

Condition Report

1019. Small chip to rim, drilled hole through mark on base where probably converted to a table lamp. Some glaze chips around drilled hole and some minor nicks/chips to glaze edge on foot. Otherwise only typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze. No cracks or repairs.
