A small group of Chinese porcelain, mostly 20th century, including a blue and white circular dish, mark of Guangxu but later, painted with opposing fenghuang, diameter 16.5cm, a Canton famille rose bowl, late 19th century, painted with figures, birds and flowers, diameter 21.2 (some faults), and two blue and white globular pots, painted with dragons, heights 9cm and 8.5cm, together with a Japanese circular bowl, height 7.5cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1187. Small blue and white dragon and phoenix water pot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Slightly larger blue and white dragon pot - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Small blue and white dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Blue and white Fenghuang dish - small chip to rim, otherwise ok.

Small blue and white vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Japanese bowl - glaze is crazed and firing crack to rim. Typical wear to enamels.

Famille rose bowl - numerous minor chips to rim and small hairline to rim, typical light surface wear.
