A pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, Meiji period, each tapered body decorated with iris on a green ground, height 12cm (some faults), with wood stands, together with a Chinese blue and white porcelain circular dish, Kangxi period, painted with flowers, diameter 26.5cm (rim repair and hairline cracks).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1048. Kangxi dish - 3cm x 1.5cm section of rim broken out and re-glued with some filler to chipped edges of this area, two small hairlines running from this repaired section. Another 2cm and 5cm hairlines to rim and numerous minor chips to rim. Typical light surface scratches.

Cloisonné vase 1 - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, two faint hairlines near base of vase.

Vase 2 - restored section of shoulder to vase and numerous hairlines to green group.
