An early 20th century mahogany framed quarter-size snooker dining table by Riley Ltd, the removable top formed from four sections, raised on fluted tapering legs, height 76cm, length 198cm, depth 104cm.

Condition Report

2097. The top has a double-level ratchet mechanism for playing and dining. It can be removed once four bolts have been unscrewed.

General condition is reasonably good overall. Top repolished and only minor knocks and wear to the legs. The baize is quite worn and the leather and netting to the pockets have some wear and loss. the top is made from one piece of slate which appears to be in good order. There are no cues or balls with the lot.
